PART 3: HERE TODAY, HERE TOMORROW

Every one of us is steering our life somewhere, whether we mean to or not. And when irresponsibility finally catches up, it rarely stays private. What starts as a “my” issue almost always becomes someone else’s problem.

CONNECT

When you look back on your life so far, what’s something you wish you had taken more seriously earlier?

LEARN

You will watch a shortened version of a message from this series to set up your group discussion. Watch the full message sometime this week to further explore what you talked about today.

APPLY

After sharing what stood out from the video, discuss the following questions as a group:

1. Why do you think people often recognize danger but still keep moving toward it?
2. Have you heard about “the law of the harvest” before? What stood out to you about it?
3. Can you explain the difference between trusting God and using “trusting God” as a way to avoid responsibility? How have you experienced this in your life?
4. Is there an area of your life where you see the danger coming but haven’t taken refuge yet? How can your group help you avoid that potential pitfall.

BEFORE NEXT TIME

Think about how you are planning responsibly for your future. Here are some specific areas:

- Relationally
- Financially
- Physically

Ask yourself if you are planning for the future appropriately.
