CONNECT

Take a few minutes to discuss this question in your group:

What excites you most about this season of life? What feels uncertain?

LEARN

Before watching the video together and discussing the questions below, we suggest taking a few moments to pray. Here's a simple prayer you can use:

Heavenly Father, thank you for giving our lives meaning and purpose in every season. Help us recognize the ways you may want to use our experience, gifts, and influence to impact others for your kingdom. Give us courage to follow where you lead. Amen.

After praying, watch the video for Part 3.

APPLY

After the video, discuss the following questions as a group:

1. What's something you've always wanted to do, pursue, or invest in that you didn't have time or capacity for during the parenting years?
2. Read **Ephesians 2:10**.

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

What stands out to you from this verse? How does it shape the way you think about purpose in this season of life?

3. What experiences (i.e., hardships, lessons, or relationships) has God used to shape your life and faith?
4. What gifts, passions, or abilities has God developed in you over the years? Who might benefit from them?
5. If you've had a burden, interest, or dream you haven't previously had time to pursue, what might it look like to take a small step toward exploring it now?



- Investing in others can bring a renewed sense of purpose in this season of life. Is that something you're currently engaged with? If so, share your experience. If not, is there a step you could take?

MOVING FORWARD

This week, spend some time reflecting on your experience, expertise, and extra time. Decide how you can intentionally use your experience, gifts, and time to impact others for God in this season of life.

PRAY

We suggest ending your group with prayer. Here's a sample prayer you can use:

Heavenly Father, thank you for creating each of us with purpose. Help us use our experience, gifts, influence, and time to serve others and point people toward you. Give us wisdom to recognize the opportunities you place in front of us and the courage to take meaningful steps of faith in this season of life. Amen.
